## PHILOSOPHY FOR CHILDREN

Philosophy for Children is a student-centered approach that engages children in **philosophizing (doing philosophy)** on important questions such as:

- What is goodness?
- What kind of life is worth living?
  - Are there different kinds of truth?

This approach, applied to Jewish education, helps children search for meaning, build identity, and develop a world view.
